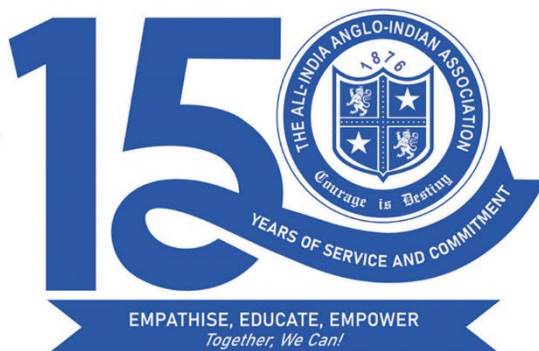

For Business Meetings Please Come Dressed Formally

i) Delegates are requested to make a voluntary contribution towards all meals, evening entertainment, Grand Delegates' Ball, and accommodation.

Category - (A) **Rs 4,000** each for **ALL** delegates who do not belong to Category (B).

Category - (B) **Rs 2,000** each for delegates who are above 15 years and below 30 years of age.

All delegates will be provided with **breakfast, lunch, evening tea and dinner at the venue**. Those delegates staying on the campus will be provided local conveyance to and from the venues for events that are not held on the school campus.

ii) Dormitory Accommodation arrangements made by organisers will be on **first-come-first-served basis**. **Only the first 350 delegates to register** for dormitory accommodation **can be accommodated at the Bishop's School, Camp**. All other delegates will need to make their own arrangements.

iii) There will be **NO reimbursement of train fare/travel cost** for delegates attending the AGM.

iv) **Only Branches that have cleared their Head Office dues up to July 2025 and sent in their Branch Rolls up to March 2025** will be eligible for board and lodging for its eligible delegates. This will be strictly adhered to by the Head Office.

v) Branch membership details will be considered as per the Branch Rolls submitted to the Head Office as of March 2025.

vi) Only members whose dues are up to date as specified in the Memorandum of Association are eligible to attend the AGM.

LAST DATE FOR SENDING IN NAMES: 10th September 2025

- **For all meals, Food and Beverage Coupons will be issued** to each delegate on arrival.
- It will not be possible for the organizers to make arrangements for local conveyance from and to the Airport or Railway Station.
- **Check-ins will only begin from 1 p.m. on Friday 17 October 2025.** Those delegates arriving earlier will need to make their own arrangements.
- Members who will be making their own arrangements for their stay should specify the same and mention that they **DO NOT** require the organisers to make arrangements for their stay in the dormitories. These outstation delegates are required to pay the voluntary contribution as mentioned above.
- Children below the age of 15 should not be brought to the Business Meetings and the Delegates' Ball. Arrangements will be made to take care of your children during the Business Meetings and the Delegates' Ball.
- Only members as defined in the Memorandum and Articles of Association can attend the Business Meetings.
- The AGM dates are during Diwali and it is a major festival all over the country. Travel tickets should be booked in advance to ensure availability as there will be a huge rush on trains and air fares will be on the higher side if booked later.
